I wanted to write to you following your appointment as Chief Executive of Worcestershire Acute Hospitals NHS Trust. I look forward to working with you in a constructive manner.

As you may already know, the Alexandra Hospital has been my top priority ever since I was first elected.

Whilst I of course welcome the major multi-million-pound investment we've seen in the Alex in recent years, which includes a brand-new operating theatres, state-of-the-art robotic surgery, a brand-new Breast Imaging Unit, an expansion of endoscopy services and the return of the Garden Suite Chemotherapy Unit, I continue to believe it should be a hospital where women can give birth and where children can receive acute medical treatment.

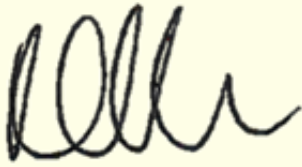
